In the Gospel today we hear about “The widow’s mite”, where Jesus points out how it is sometimes those who have the least to give that are the most generous. It challenges us all to ask how generous we really are with our money, our possessions, our time, our love.

**Remembering our loved ones:** Today, during the 11am Mass, all deceased parishioners and friends of the parish will be remembered and a candle lit for each of them.

**Armistice Day:** Thursday 11th November at 11am. The High School are holding a service of remembrance in front of the school. Everyone is welcome to gather outside the school to join in with the service where we will remember all those who have given their lives in war and conflict. A representative number of the students lead and be present outside at the service while all the others will keep the silence in their classrooms.

**Remembrance Sunday.** Next Sunday is Remembrance Sunday. We will mark this in our traditional way at the 11am Mass that day followed by a procession to the Parish War Memorial on Duddle Lane for prayers and the laying of wreaths.

**Covid19 Restrictions:** Please continue to be careful and respectful of each other as we try to find balance between limiting the chances of spreading infection while seeking ways to return to a more normal way of life. And interacting with each other.

**Mass Obligation:** The Sunday Mass obligation is still dispensed, but, if you are not attending in person, do try to watch a Mass online or pray with the sheet “The Lord’s Day at Home”. The Bishops have indicated that they would like to re-introduce the obligation on the 1st Sunday of Advent.
