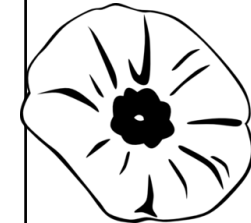

Quarant' Ore: To conclude the liturgical year, we will hold 40 hours of Private Prayer with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from **Thurs 18th to Sun 21st November:** 10am to 8pm on Thursday and Friday; 10am to 6.30pm on Sat and 12-6pm on Sunday. Come and pray for your intentions and those of our world. Please sign up for an hour of prayer on the list at the back of the church.

Sanctuary lamps will be available for £10 in memory of a loved one or for a special prayer intention. The 9 day lamp will be lit for the duration of the 40 hours and then used throughout the year, as our sanctuary lamp in church for that week.
