**Confirmation:** Young people from our local parishes are preparing together for the Sacrament of Confirmation each Sunday evening at 7.15-8.15 after the evening Mass for the next few weeks. Confirmation will be celebrated by Bishop John Arnold on **Sunday 3rd July at the 6.30pm Mass.**

**Sunday Obligation:** As most restrictions for Covid19 are now lifted, the Bishops' Conference for England and Wales have reinstated the obligation for Catholics to attend mass on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation. Do encourage your friends and neighbours to return to Mass. Copies of the full statement are available from the church entrances and on the parish website. Our Mass attendance last weekend was as follows: Vigil: 62; 9.30am: 218 (1st Communions); 11am: 93; 6.30pm: 76. Total of 449.

**Gift Aid:** A big thank you to all who Gift Aid their collection, either by standing order or envelopes. As a result, the parish will receive £14,623.39 from the Inland Revenue for the tax year 2021/22. We will also receive a further £2,503.62 as a result of gift aided donations made to the church. Remember, you must have paid at least the same amount of tax to cover the reclaimed Gift Aid amount, i.e. if you give £10 per week, that equals £520 per year and the parish claims £130, so you must have paid at least £130 tax in the year.
