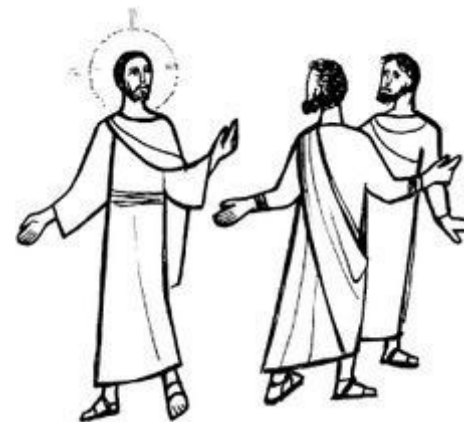

TODAY: 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time
We have the first “Ordinary Time” Sunday since before Lent and we resume reading St Luke’s Gospel at a very significant verse: 9:51: “Jesus resolutely took the road for Jerusalem”. The mission reaches a crucial point—moving from teaching and healing around various towns and places to begin the journey to His suffering death and resurrection. There are times in all our lives where we have to grasp the nettle and make decisive moves. We pray today for the wisdom to make good decisions and to walk resolutely in the path Our Lord is calling us to follow.

First Holy Communions: This Sunday we have our third group of children making their First Holy Communion at the 9.30 Mass. Keep the children and their families in your prayers. A celebration Mass and Communion breakfast for all of them will take place on Sunday 10th July at 9.30am.

Refugee Week: This week, **Brownedge St Mary’s High School** is holding a **Refugee Week**, as an opportunity to raise awareness of the stories of those seeking a safe place of refuge as celebrating the impact refugees make to our society. As part of this week a charity will be setting up an ‘Escape to Safety’ immersive experience in the school gym. This is a walk-through experience that simulates the journey of a refugee. The journey is based on real life experiences. We would love to invite anyone from the parish who would like to experience this to come along to school of the evening of **Tuesday, 28 June, anytime between 3.30pm to 5pm.** For anyone who

would like to take part in this evening, please come to the school reception, where you will then be guided through the experience.
